Anil Sahasrabudhe did his BE in Mechanical Engineering in 1980 from Karnataka University securing First Rank and a Gold Medal. He did his Masters in 1982 and PhD in 1989 both from Indian Institute of Science Bangalore. In between he had brief stints of working as Scientific Officer in IISc (1983), and Engineer Trainee in Tata Consulting Engineers (1983-84) and as Lecturer in North Eastern Regional Institute of Science and Technology, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh (1987-88) where he returned again after his PhD in 1989 as Assistant Professor. He joined as Associate Professor in 1995 in newly started Indian Institute of Technology, Guwahati and became Professor in 1999. He held responsibilities such as Head of Mechanical Engineering, Chairman, Library Committee, Chairman JEE, Dean Academic Affairs and Deputy Director till 2006. He thereafter joined on deputation in College of Engineering Pune as Director. One of the major tasks achieved has been turnaround of an institute and bringing it in reckoning amongst the top 15-20 institutes in India. Despite administrative responsibilities, he has been all along teaching several courses related to mechanical engineering. He has guided more than 60 post-graduate/graduate level projects apart from 9 PhD students and published more than 60 research papers, participated/organized several research seminars and conferences. He has been associated with professional societies such as ASI, ISTE, IE, ASME, IET, ASEE etc. He is a recipient of Praj intrapreneur award (2011), National Award for eminent educationist : Indo-Global Education Summit & Expo 2013 and Edupreneur Award 2013 from Engineering Watch. He is currently Chairman of All India Council for Technical Education and has been bringing in reforms in technical education system in India. The Smart India Hackathon, AICTE's Start up policy, development of SWAYAM, a MOOCs platform and several other new quality initiatives are some of the actions changing the technical education scenario in India.
